Eligibility Criteria

You may qualify if you:

- are 17 or older and not enrolled in high school
- are legally eligible to work in the U.S.
- are unemployed or underemployed (part-time or low-wage incomes)
- are not academically prepared for college (based on Test of Adult Basic Education)

Requirements

To participate, you must:

- call to register (application, basic skills test and interview required)
- complete a background study (\$20)
- be physically and emotionally prepared to perform healthcare work (most healthcare careers require lifting, standing for 8 hour shifts, night, weekend & holiday hours, and close contact with others)
- commit to attending class periods and at least 6 hours of homework per week
