Eligibility Criteria

You may qualify if you:

- will be at least 18 years old by December 15, 2014
- are legally eligible to work in the U.S.
- are unemployed or underemployed,
- are not academically prepared for college (based on Test of Adult Basic Education)
- have a HS Diploma or GED complete by December 15, 2014

Requirements

To participate, you must:

- call to complete TABE testing and an intake interview
- be physically able to perform manufacturing work (requires heavy lifting and standing for 8 – 12 hour shifts)
- commit to attending every class and about 10 hours of homework per week
