Qualifications for taking the GED test include:

- Being a Minnesota resident
- Not being enrolled in high school
- Being at least 19 years old (if under 19, an approved age waiver is needed)

The GED test has sections of language arts, math, science and social studies. GED test preparation services and practice tests are available at Lincoln Community Center. Each section of the test is signed up and paid for on-line through Pearson Vue Testing Services. The tests are given in the computer lab at Lincoln Community Center.

Computer skills needed to pass the tests include:

- Typing
- Using drop-down menus
- Dragging and dropping images
- Using an imbedded calculator
