Eligibility Criteria

Call for questions about eligibility for this FREE adult career-pathway course. You may qualify if you:

- Are 16 or older and not enrolled in high school
- Are legally eligible to work in the U.S.
- Are unemployed or underemployed (part-time or low-wage incomes)
- Are not academically prepared for college (eligibility is determined by the Test of Adult Basic Education)

Requirements

To participate, students must:

- Call to register—application, basic skills test and interview required
- Complete a background study (\$20)
- Be physically and emotionally prepared to perform healthcare work (most healthcare careers require lifting, standing for 8 hour shifts, night, weekend & holiday hours, and close contact with others)
- Commit to attending class periods and at least 6 hours of homework per week



Free Training for Adults

Students who successfully complete the "Pathways to Healthcare" course may qualify for resources to attend Basic Nursing 101 and/ or Medical Terminology in Fall Semester at South Central College.
