## Eligibility Criteria

**You may qualify if you:**

- Will be at least 18 years old by December 15, 2014
- Are legally eligible to work in the U.S.
- Are unemployed or underemployed
- Are not academically prepared for college (eligibility is determined by the Test of Adult Basic Education)
- Have a HS Diploma or GED complete by December 15, 2014

## Requirements

**To participate, students must:**

- Call us to complete TABE testing and an intake interview
- Be physically able to perform manufacturing work (requires heavy lifting & standing for 8-12 hour shifts)
- Commit to attending every class and about 10 hours of homework per week
