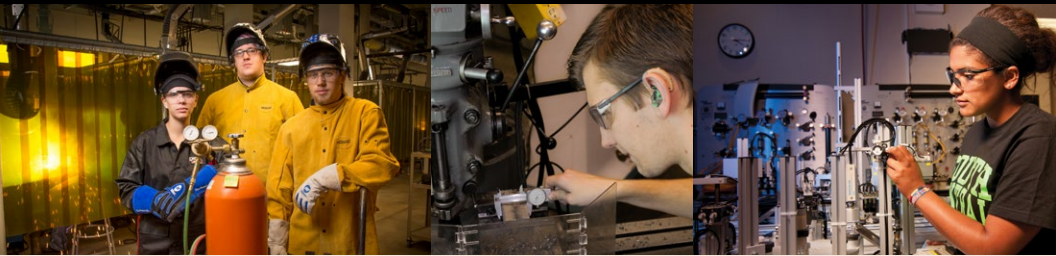

Eligibility & Participation Criteria

To qualify to participate you must:

- Be 18 years old by July 1
- Have a HS Diploma or GED by July 1
- Be legally eligible to work in the U.S.
- Take the Test of Adult Basic Education with results indicating you are not academically prepared for college
- Be physically able to perform manufacturing work
- Commit to attending class and completing homework each week
