Eligibility & Participation Criteria

To qualify to participate you must:

- Be at least 18 years old by June 6, 2016
- Be legally eligible to work in the U.S.
- Take the Test of Adult Basic Education with results indicating you are not academically prepared for college
- Be physically able to perform as a truck driver
- Have a Minnesota Class D Driver's License
- Commit to attending class and completing homework each week
