4-YEAR OR MORE COLLEGE DEGREE AND/OR EQUIVALENT EXPERIENCE

CONSTRUCTION MANAGERS \$39.34

Plan, direct, or coordinate, usually through subordinate supervisory personnel, activities concerned with the construction and maintenance of structures, facilities, and systems. Participate in the conceptual development of a construction project and oversee its organization, scheduling, budgeting, and implementation. Includes managers in specialized construction fields, such as carpentry or plumbing.

CIVIL ENGINEERS \$41.44

Perform engineering duties in planning, designing, and overseeing construction and maintenance of building structures, and facilities, such as roads, railroads, airports, bridges, harbors, channels, dams, irrigation projects, pipelines, power plants, and water and sewage systems.

1-2-YEAR COLLEGE DEGREE OR APPRENTICESHIP

HEATING, VENTILATION, & AIR CONDITIONING \$23.75

Install or repair heating, central air conditioning, or refrigeration systems, including oil burners, hot-air furnaces, and heating stoves.

PLUMBERS, PIPEFITTERS, AND STEAMFITTERS \$25.09

Union Apprenticeship \$16.77 with benefits is a total package of **\$30.83**
Union Journeyman \$30.14 with benefits is a total package of **\$54.54**

Assemble, install, alter, and repair pipelines or pipe systems that carry water, steam, air, or other liquids or gases. May install heating and cooling equipment and mechanical control systems. Includes sprinkler fitters.

ELECTRICIANS \$27.60

Union Apprenticeship \$21.60 with benefits is a total package of **\$35.84**
Union Journeyman \$43.20 with benefits is a total package of **\$67.00**

Install maintain, and repair electrical wiring, equipment, and fixtures. Ensure that work is in accordance with relevant codes. May install or service street lights, intercom systems, or electrical control systems.

CARPENTERS \$23.37

Union Apprenticeship \$17.46 with benefits is a total package of **\$34.11**

Construct, erect, install, or repair structures and fixtures made of wood, such as concrete forms; building frameworks, including partitions, joists, studding, and rafters; and wood stairways, window and door frames, and hardwood floors. May also install cabinets, siding, drywall and batt or roll insulation. Includes brattice builders who build doors or brattices (ventilation walls or partitions) in underground passageways.

CEMENT MASONS AND CONCRETE FINISHERS \$20.48

Smooth and finish surfaces of poured concrete, such as floors, walks, sidewalks, roads, or curbs using a variety of hand and power tools. Align forms for sidewalks, curbs, or gutters; patch voids; and use saws to cut expansion joints.

CONSTRUCTION AND BUILDING INSPECTORS \$34.31

Inspect structures using engineering skills to determine structural soundness and compliance with specifications, building codes, and other regulations. Inspections may be general in nature or may be limited to a specific area, such as electrical systems or plumbing.

CONSTRUCTION LABORERS \$18.20

Highway Heavy Union Apprenticeship \$24.41

Perform tasks involving physical labor at construction sites. May operate hand and power tools of all types: air hammers, earth tampers, cement mixers, small mechanical hoists, surveying and measuring equipment, and a variety of other equipment and instruments. May clean and prepare sites, dig trenches, set braces to support the sides of excavations, erect scaffolding, and clean up rubble, debris and other waste materials. May assist other craft workers.
